Meeting minutes

President started the meeting.

- Started with review of Chapter Webpage and review of sponsorship page. Annual \$500 donation or equivalent value of services required to be chapter sponsor. 1st – Curtis, 2nd Greig, Unanimous vote to make sponsorship changes. Nomination to make Nain and Associates chapter sponsor based on services provided – 1st Curtis, 2nd Greig, unanimous vote yes with Adam abstaining. Nomination to make Shurtape a chapter sponsor based on services provided – 1st Greig, 2nd Curtis, unanimous votes yes with Rick abstaining.
- Safety Awards Banquet – Curtis volunteered to speak and help Erika with opening comments. Adam will show up to write the appropriate checks and make sure they are good. Discussion about continuing to co-host the Safety Award Banquet. Rick and Curtis would like to continue and volunteered to help coordinate next year's event and keep the chapter going as a co-host.
- Financial Report – Adam went over the annual financial report for 2025-2026.
- Chapter School - Adam then discussed the 32nd Safety School chapter costs and we went over on costs by around \$700.00. Group discussed not ordering extra meals next year and looking at an increase in dues to offset the costs.
- Election – no new volunteers or nominated names. One person per role which allows for a voice vote. The motion is for all officers to remain in the same role. Unanimous yes votes.
- Chapter Officer recruitment and benefits. Jason discussed with the team we need to look at ways to recruit the future of the chapter while at the same time taking care of current leaders. Jason discussed with the team Chapter events where we volunteer and coordinate the event should not come to a cost for the volunteer leader. Jason shared he supports purchasing Adam's flight to attend Safety 26. Unanimous vote yes with Adam abstaining.
